- 4) We used to play a racquet tournament amongst some of the guys at the club. We included badminton, tennis, racquetball and short tennis. As predicted Ross wiped us all out in the first 3 events and came 2nd in the short tennis. It was a blast and Ross got to showcase his natural abilities because he really didn't play anything but racquetball at the time.
- 5) Often over the summer months, Ross and a few of our sports friends, would come over to my house to play pool volleyball, eat dinner and play scrabble. He was even the BEST AT SCRABBLE!
- 6) Ross was admired by club members and members were proud that Ross would come to the club and partake in activities with them. Always complimentary, he would tell members that they were improving or that he thought that they were playing well. Ross made people feel good about themselves.
